

## Kyle & Lochalsh Community Trust Community Grants

### Grants of up to £50 available to groups in Lochalsh

Kyle & Lochalsh Community Trust (KLCT) has launched a community fund to support organisations in Lochalsh with small grants of up to £50. The fund is particularly targeted at groups that have been impacted by Covid-19. Organisations with a constitution and bank account, working in any of the 7 community council areas of Lochalsh (Kyle, Plockton & District, Lochalsh, Dornie & District, Strome ferry & Achmore, Loch Duich, Glenelg & Arnisdale) can apply.

The trust is aware that the grant size is small, so encourages groups to consider applying to the Highland Council Ward Discretionary Fund.

Kyle & Lochalsh Community Trust grant will be allocated on a first come first served basis to groups that meet the criteria below. The first round will close on the 4 December 2021, but we would encourage you to send in your application as soon as possible.

#### Check you fit the criteria:


- Are you a constituted community group, organisation or sports club?
- Are you based in Lochalsh? (Community council areas Kyle, Plockton & District, Lochalsh, Dornie & District, Strome ferry & Achmore, Loch Duich, Glenelg & Arnisdale)
- Does your organisation have its own bank account?
- Has your organisation been affected by Covid-19? (Such as unable to work within your community or fundraise, or you have been providing extra community support)

#### The grants will prioritise applications that support one or more of:

- Children
- Young people
- Older people
- Those with specific needs
- Wellbeing and mental health

If your project does not fit the criteria, you can apply but decisions will be at the discretion of KLCT.
